What is the IAP?//

- ▲ The IAP is a voluntary program which provides heavy vehicles with improved access to Australia's road network in return for monitoring of compliance with specific access conditions using vehicle telematics solutions.



How does it work? // (1)

- ▲ Monitoring of vehicle route compliance is required under all IAP Applications.
- ▲ Monitoring of other parameters is optional, depending on the requirements of the road authority.
- ▲ Non-compliant operation is reported to the relevant road authority in the form of a non-compliance report (NCR).



How does it work? // (2)

- ▲ IAP Service Providers are certified by TCA.
- ▲ Only IAP Service Providers can supply IAP services.



IAP is live //

- ▲ The IAP has entered its 'live' phase and is operational.
- ▲ Sigtec Pty Ltd announced as first IAP Service Provider.



IAP – delivering productivity benefits //(1)

An IAP case study:

- ▲ Basin Sands Logistics in Broken Hill.
- ▲ Part of the Consolidated Group of companies owned by Steve and Margaret Radford, employing 170 full time staff and operating some 375 items of plant, carrying out business as general contractors nationally.

IAP – delivering productivity benefits //(2)

An IAP case study:

- ▲ Carrying mineral sands
- ▲ From **81t** Gross Combination Mass using double Road Trains at CML (Concessional Mass Limits).
- ▲ To **113t** Gross Combination Mass using AB-Triples under the NSW Road Train Modernisation Program at HML (Higher Mass Limits) with the IAP.



IAP – delivering productivity benefits //(3)

An IAP case study:

- ▲ According to Basin Sands Logistics this translates into a significant productivity gain per truck per annum.
- ▲ Benefit will be shared with their client.
- ▲ Basin Sands Logistics worked with both Broken Hill City Council and Wentworth Shire to make this happen.



Conclusion //

- ▲ IAP is ready and operational
- ▲ National regulatory framework and technical platform
- ▲ Can combine regulatory and commercial fleet management services
- ▲ Quality assured system providing evidentiary quality data
