## **TCA STATEMENT REGARDING INTERMEC CN3**

Transport Certification Australia Limited (TCA), the company administering the Intelligent Access Program (IAP), has become aware of articles that have appeared in the media recently regarding a relationship between Intermec and Transtech Driven, an IAP Service Provider, in which the Intermec CN3 is identified as being a 'fully IAP-compatible mobile computer'.

TCA would like to make clear that, although these articles refer to a relationship between Intermec and Transtech Driven, Intermec is not an IAP Service Provider and is not authorised to provide IAP services or equipment. The Intermec CN3 mobile computer referred to has not been assessed by TCA for IAP compatibility and is not part of any current IAP Service Provider system.

With the IAP operational, TCA would like to remind transport operators that IAP services and equipment can only be provided by IAP Service Providers.

At the current time, Sigtec Pty Ltd and Transtech Driven are the only available IAP Service Providers and, consequently, are the only companies authorised to supply transport operators with IAP services and equipment.
