Intelligent Access Program



- Transport operators agree improved road access with road authorities
- In return for being monitored by satellite for compliance with conditions (eg route, time, mass) attached to the access





Intelligent Access Program



- Monitoring is by an independent certified third party IAP Service Provider
- IAP Service Provider installs its 'black box' (in-vehicle unit) the transport operator's vehicle and reports non-compliance to the road authority
- Non-compliance generally jeopardizes continuation access (but not a police matter)





Transport Certification Australia Ltd



- Company formed by road authorities of State, Territory and Commonwealth governments
- Role is to administer and implement the IAP and certify and audit IAP Service Providers





Collaborative opportunities in IAP



- Development of customised access conditions
- Tool assisting chain of responsibility compliance
- Transport operators can use IAP to negotiate improved road access that will assist them in achieving their business and operational needs.
