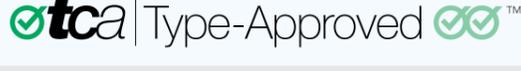

Our logos help stakeholders understand, at a glance, the level of assurance available from the ASPs and suppliers operating in the National Telematics Framework.
